

Pinnacle Sports Productions (3v3 Live Soccer Tour) Waiver. Every player, or guardian if the player is under age 18, must read this waiver form. Signatures on the registration form signify each person has read, understands, and abides by this information.

There are risks connected with my participation in this tournament and its related activities (risks may include but not limited to muscle injuries, heat and stress related issues, cuts, lacerations and broken bones). I release and discharge Pinnacle Sports Productions, event sponsors, event charities (collectively known as event organizers) and the workers, employees and directors from all action, suits and demands whatsoever in law or in equity, including but not limited to, the risk of personal injury from playing in the tournament and the risk of loss of personal property by theft or otherwise. Player eligibility for NCAA, collegiate sports and local school districts vary. The event organizers are not responsible for determining each players' eligibility.

Further, I hereby grant full permission for event organizers to record any or all of my participation in this event for photos, motion pictures, TV, radio, recordings and other media known or unknown, and to use them, in any matter including publicity, promotions advertising trade or commercial purposes, without any reimbursement of any kind due to me. Players, reserve players, managers, coaches, and fans are expected to conduct themselves within the letter and spirit of "The Laws of the Game." The Tournament Director has the authority and the responsibility to remove any person(s) from the tournament for abuses of conduct. In addition to good manners, the following rules will apply to the 3v3 Live National Championships:

The Tournament Director will designate one sideline to be for the sole use of the players listed on the game roster and a maximum total of two (2) managers/coaches/trainers from each team, with one team occupying one side of the mid field and one team, the other.

While the game is in progress the manager/coach/trainer and substitutes must remain in their respective bench area and may not roam the sidelines. Failure to remain in designated bench area during play may result in a caution (yellow card).

The manager/coach will be responsible for the behavior of their fans and the referee will have the authority to warn (yellow card) and ultimately send off (red card), any manager/coach who behaves (or whose fans behave) in an abusive or disruptive manner.

Coaches or parents that are sent off must leave the complex for the rest of the day.
