BYF PARENT COMMITMENT FORM GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCT OF PARENTS AND FANS.

MUST READ PRIOR TO REGISTERING YOUR CHILD

Taunting and harassing referees, players or coaches will result in severe penalties to the team and could affect the outcome of the game. The discourteous fan will be removed from the game and possibly banned from future games. The BYF Association Board will also impose player suspensions base on violation of this policy. We have ZERO tolerance for inappropriate behavior from players, parents, and fans.

Enjoy the game! Please remember that the coaches, players, and referees can make mistakes.

Alcoholic beverages / Illegal drugs- Are not permitted on the practice or game field at home and away games. Anyone appearing to be "Under the Influence" of alcohol or drugs will be reported to the Brawley Policy Department AND will be banned from BYF designated events. This is also covered by our ZERO Tolerance Policy.

How to report concerns: There are times during the season when parents may have a concern about any one of a variety of issues. When this occurs, we request that you wait until after practice or a game to address the issue your child's head coach and/or team parent.

Parent Volunteer Responsibility: BYF is a volunteer non-profit organization. It takes many individuals and group effort to maintain and keep an athletic organization running efficiently. The present and future success of the program is dependent upon your support.

We require every player's parents and/ or guardians to pitch in and help the association. With this commitment of assistance from every player's family, BYF is able to keep operating costs down. It is mandatory for parents/guardians to fulfill a required number of volunteer duties during the season. A roster of duties will be assigned at registration by the Volunteer Coordinator or Team Mom and you will be sent a reminder well before your responsibilities are required. Unfortunately, if these positions are not fulfilled your child will be removed from the game in which you were to volunteer. We DO NOT want to remove a player from a game, it is imperative that you adhere to your commitment or make arrangements well in advance with your Team Mom.

Each player's family will be required to volunteer in the following duties, but not limited to, throughout the course of the season.
